

# **GOD IS: TRUSTING GOD IN TURBULENT TIMES (FAMILY STUDY GUIDE)**

## **LESSON #9: ENGRAVED ON HIS PALMS (ISAIAH 49:1-26)**

### **Step 1: Big Ideas**

Chapter 49 introduces a major shift in Isaiah.

#### **CHAPTER 40-48**

- How will God deliver the Jews from Babylon?
- Focus on first deliverer: Cyrus the Persian
- Hope is for the Jews to be restored to the land

#### **CHAPTER 49-55**

- How will God deliver the Jews from sin?
- Focus on the ultimate deliverer: Servant of the Lord
- Hope is for the nations to be restored to God

**Big Question:** How will God fix the bigger problem of sin?

The Servant of the Lord is Jesus Christ. Through Jesus, born as a baby, God will be glorified, and salvation will come!

### **Step 2: Read**

Isaiah 49:1-26

### **Step 3: Reflect**

The Servant of the Lord is Jesus Christ.

Who is Jesus? How will God fix the bigger problem of sin through Jesus?

Use Isaiah 49 and what you know from bible reading to write words to describe Jesus.

Reread Isaiah 49:16

You are special to God.

These words were first  
spoken many years ago. God  
tells his people that he has  
written their name on his  
hand.

God cares about you just as  
much today as he cared  
about the people he called  
way back then.

Put your name in the heart  
and remember you are  
precious in God's eyes!



#### Step 4: Memorize

Isaiah 49:16a

Behold,  
I have engraved you on  
the palms of my hands

#### Step 5: Prayer

Lord, I give you thanks for sending your son Jesus. Thank you for loving me and forgiving me of my sins. Thank you for reminding me that I am precious in your eyes and my name is engraved on the palm of your hand. Thank you! In Jesus name, Amen.
