Step 1: Big Ideas

GOD IS SOVERIGN (SUPREME RULER) AND TRUSTWORTHY!

Isaiah 48 can be divided in two major parts with two major themes.

GOD IS SOVERIGN	GOD IS TRUSTWORTHY
HE RULES OVER ALL	WE CAN TRUST HIM
(48:1-11)	(48:12-22)

- 1. The Jewish exile in Babylon will give God the chance to show his sovereignty over history and that we can trust him to fulfill his promises.
- 2. God will deliver his people from Babylon and they are to declare to the world that God is sovereign and can be trusted.

Step 3: Reflect


